Draft 2008 Amendments to the LTCCP 2006-16 April 2008

The Fendalton/Waimairi Community Board (the Board) makes the following submissions on the consultation document. The Board would like to be heard.

1. Kerbside Collection

- 1.1 The Board supports the new kerbside collection proposal and the preferred option and congratulates the Council on the efforts made to reduce the amount of waste going to the landfill. The Board asks whether residents will be able to have smaller sized bins if they request it.
- 1.2 The Board encourages the placement of information stickers on the inside lid of the bins for promotion and education including whether material such as cabbage tree leaves can be placed in the green waste bin.
- 1.3 The Board questions whether there is anything in the new system to preclude residents from putting green waste into other bins or all their household rubbish including recycling into the one bin.

2. Revenue and Finance Policy

- 21. The Board supports the rural rate differential
- The Board considers that the Uniform Annual General Charge remains too low. However, due to the costs involved in the kerbside collection it does not consider that the UAGC should be raised in the 2008/09 financial year. The Board does consider that the Council should consider raising the UAGC as part of the 2009/29 LTCCP.
