I have just attended the Anzac Ceremony held at the New Brighton Cenotaph, the service brought home to me the significance of 'our' Community hall. The hall was built by local labour and finance and named the 'Peace Memorial Hall' to commemorate those from North Beach who died for their Country in two world wars, and here we are again fighting for the extra funding needed to restore our hall to its former glory.

Additional funding was granted for earthquake strengthening and to ensure the new design including the innovative deck and stairway to the beach could be built, as the Council plan showed:
