Lake Hood – approx. 1 hour from Christchurch</li><li>2. Lake Taniwha – approx. 3-4 hours from Christchurch.</li></ol> <p>I would prefer to see money being invested in Kerr's Reach, where the associated clubs already have their sheds, etc. Develop the area there, say spend \$500,000 making more use of the land surrounding the river, allowing more sheds to be built, widening, dredging, etc. and then annually ensure that money is spent cutting/clearing out the weed.</p> <p>Why does Christchurch think it has to have international facilities for every sport?</p> <p>Why not let other cities, towns etc. have some financial return from hosting internationals, and Christchurch people could travel to those areas themselves, and see some other parts of NZ.</p> <p><b>Re: New Civic Offices Building - \$53.71M 2004/14 CCC Plan - Page 29.</b></p> <p>I am opposed to New Civic Offices Building – as I believe that use of an existing building would be adequate, if it is even necessary to move from the current building.</p> <p>I believe there are a number of buildings in Christchurch that are vacant.</p> <p><b>Re: New Swimming Pool - \$10M 2004/14CCC Plan - Page 29</b></p> <p>I am opposed to spending this amount of money for yet another swimming pool in Christchurch.
