- \* Areas of land projected to be acquired or purchased within the next 3-10 years are lineal projections based on past acquisitions/purchases and projected population figures. Fluctuations may occur from year to year due to larger areas of land being acquired/purchased in some years, with less land acquired/purchased in other years. The figures shown are an indication of the total amount of reserve and stormwater land Council is currently expected to acquire or purchase over the next 3-10 years. Please also note the affect of an open space assessment (scheduled to occur within the next 3 years via the Open Space Strategy) and the Banks Peninsula merger may also have an affect on these projected figures.
- \*\* These documents may be subject to review once the open space assessment has been undertaken via the Open Space Strategy.

Please also note there are several existing stormwater cost-sharing schemes in place (as disclosed within the LTCCP) that form part of the existing Development Contribution process, in the form of revenue gathered by Council.
