

P 74 CAPITAL WORKS PROGRAMME

The Barbadoes Street Cultural Zone Development Group, representing the Music Centre of Christchurch, the Cathedral Parish, the Christchurch School of Music, and CPIT are disappointed that the "Central City Revitalisation Project" is not a priority project for capital spending.

Taking into consideration the recent South City Charrette and the considerable community efforts put into the process, it is essential that follow up implementation of projects can be achieved. Capital funding for this is essential.

Given the community input into the Charrette and the many other central city projects over recent years, it is extremely disappointing when implementation does not follow. This can only lead to a general disillusionment with the whole process and to a lack of community involvement in future projects.
