Do you have any comments on the major projects in our Draft Community Plan?
Yes, as I reside in the central city, I am most concerned about:
(1) The Avon River strategy-I'd like to see Cambridge Terrace closed between Barbados and Churchill Streets, and made into a park. There should be cycle trails and walkways on both sides of the entire length of the Avon.
(2) The Central City Transport Strategy-Block off more streets for pedestrians and cyclists only. Install a CyberTran public transportation system.
(3) Streets and transport improvements- Make all one-way streets into two-way streets. To discourage cars, encourage traffic congestion by making all streets no more than one lane going in each direction. Remove the street parking on the narrow streets like Columbo, and replace it with cycle trails separated from the cars by verges planted with trees and plants.
(4) The Botanic Gardens project-More sculptures and artwork is needed in the gardens. Bring back archers to the Archery Lawn.
(5) The City Mall renovation-We need many more pedestrian malls, like on High Street and the area around the Art Centre, Art Gallery and Museum.
Do you have any comments on groups of activities (The activities and services the Council provides?)
Reduce crime by:
(1) Assigning 2 police officers to every small area of a few blocks, where they knock on doors and get to know everyone in their area.
(2) Remove drug addicts from the public eye and get them into a treatment program.

(3) Get prostitutes off of the streets and working in brothels. Require them to carry health cards, noting that they've been tested for drugs, AIDS and STD's

every month.

Do you have any other comments or suggestions you want to make?

- (1) The "red light district"-This should be much smaller than at present, so that it doesn't include the City Council building. It doesn't need to include massage parlours, as these are not brothels. However, Christchurch needs more brothels in the city and suburbs, to get the prostitutes off of the streets.
- (2) Latimer Square-Design it using Feng Shui principles as a Peace Park, with a Tibetan style peace pagoda incorporated into the design.
- (3) Seal the entire length of the Christchurch to Little River Rail Trail and dedicate it to Rod Donald.
