COMMENTS ON COMMUNITY PLAN 2006 TO 16 DRAFT SUMMARY.

1. I am concerned that the allocation of funds to broad areas often has a strong historical component.

My proposal is that the changing demographics of Christchurch be monitored on an ongoing basis, and that each time rates are set, the suitability of the proposed budget be considered in relation to the directions of demographic change.

2. I am concerned with the size of the annual increase in rates.

This year the Council produced a work programme for 2 draft budgets, for ratepayer comment, each with different rate increases. It did **not** produce a project list for a budget with zero rate increase, or with an increase limited to the rate of inflation.

My proposal is that at each budget, two options should be presented for ratepayer consideration. One, a work programme based on a rate increase restricted to that of increase in the CPI; and the second, the Council's recommended work programme, with its consequent rate increase. I consider it to be poor stewardship not to indicate clearly what work would have to be omitted if the rate increase was limited.
