- 1. This plan appears to be about killing off the building industry in Christchurch. Our understanding is that consent fees are likely to increase by approx \$10000 per consent from 1 July 2006. This will undoubtedly put many possible projects on the back burner a lot will be there indefinitely.
- 2. This proposal will categorically reduce the number of jobs the industry has worked hard to create over recent times. We would not imagine this is what the council would want to see happen, given that they have lobbied hard on their ability to create jobs.
- 3. Many developers and builders have developments / buildings priced and sold based on the existing development contribution levy structure. The Draft 2006 LTCCP introduction makes no allowance for existing contracts (land sale and purchase, building) where consents are not in place
